Rewards in school

Our new behaviour system has a huge emphasis on whole school rewards, celebrating what children do well and sharing this to support others. This year, we are collecting points as rewards for following our school values, and of course, SHAPE. The children will be given these in the form of dojo points and can be given either 1, 2 or 3 points at any time. There are lots of whole school rewards this year too, so we can celebrate how fantastic our children are, including bouncy castles and prize draws!

Some classes have previously used Dojo points in the past and parents have been able to see them at home. We are looking into how we can once again share children's achievements via this method, but this takes slightly longer to set up when using it for a whole school. We will send this information out as soon as we can.

Nether Edge Primary Uniform Policy

White polo shirt or white shirt

These can be bought from any shops and do not need the school logo on, although these are also available.

School sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan – Compulsory

These need to be ordered through the school office or bought directly from our suppliers, Pinders Leisurewear and must have the school logo.

Trousers/skirts

Plain black or grey with no other colour or adornment. Leggings should only be worn with dresses. Tights should also be black or grey. No denim is permitted (even if in black).

Dresses

They should be green (school colour) checked pattern or grey or black plain.

Parents/Carers should not invest in clothing that will fade over time as this will need to be replaced.

Footwear

Shoes, trainers or boots must be completely black without any other colour trim or coloured logo.

During periods of severe weather, wellingtons and snow boots are permitted.

Examples of shoes unsuitable for school wear



Cultural Dress

Headscarves must be plain and in school colours (black, green or white). Headscarves must not have loose or trailing material.

Jewellery

No jewellery is permitted for the interests of the children's safety. No make-up should be worn.

Hairstyle

Hairstyles and colour must be appropriate for school. Outlandish styles and colours are not permitted. Shaved patterns should also be avoided (for example the Nike swoosh).



Equipment

Book bags are needed by every pupil. These should be black, grey or navy blue.

PE Kit

A complete change of clothing is required for PE lessons.

Students should wear the following:

Plain black sports shorts, tracksuit bottoms or leggings

White plain T-shirt.

Black plain plimsolls or trainers.

Headscarves may be worn but must not have loose or trailing material.

Students are expected to wear this and participate in lessons.

General

All of the above items must be of a style that is suitable for a day's learning at school. The Headteacher will ultimately decide on matters concerning the suitability of items for school.

Sweatshirts and cardigans should be ordered through the school office or bought directly from our suppliers, Pinders Leisurewear and have the school logo on. No other jumpers, shirts, cardigans should be worn in school.

If families are struggling finding uniform for their children then school will assist them in finding appropriate clothing. Please ask in school about this.
